Finger Lakes for Peace in Iraq is a group working nonviolently to end the Iraq war by challenging members of the U.S. Congress to publicly declare that they will vote against any further funding for the occupation and war in Iraq. We are part of a campaign of sustained nonviolent civil disobedience and other activities toward this goal.

We support the following positive U.S. policy alternatives to war:

- **Provide a formal apology to the Iraqi People**
- **Support an international peacekeeping mission acceptable to Iraq.**
- **Fund the rebuilding of Iraq by and for Iraqis.**
- **Withdraw from Iraq all U.S. military forces and military contractors.**
- **Cleanup unexploded munitions and depleted uranium.**
- **Fully provide for the medical and psychological needs of Iraq war veterans and civilians harmed by the war.**
- **Pay restitution to civilians harmed by the war.**
- **Remove the U.S. Governments and U.S. Corporations control over Iraq's oil, economic policy and political process.**
- **Disavow the policies of pre-emptive war and torture, and re-commit our nation to the intention of the Geneva Convention and the UN Charter**
- **Redirect U.S. Military spending toward sustainable development and human needs in the U.S.**
